CVMA U Online *Real-Time* Course Format

Online Real-Time courses can be taken from anywhere with a computer and high-speed connection.

- The courses are divided into three, two-hour virtual sessions scheduled to take place on Wednesdays from 12:30-2:30pm CT. If unable to attend the live session, students will receive a link to the recorded session.
- Students receive course materials via their email accounts.
- The instructor presents information while showing the power point on the screen.
- Students have time for live questions and discussions that are included on the recorded link.
- No completion of an exam is required.
- All who successfully complete the course receive an official letter of completion for six (6) RACE credit hours

CVMA U *On-Demand* Course Format

On-Demand courses can be taken anytime and anywhere with a computer and a high-speed internet connection.

- No planes, trains, automobiles, or traffic. No worries about proper attire
- Take the course and the exam at your own pace.
- Content is recorded and the link is provided to the student. Recorded content includes the instructor's power point presentation facilitated by the subject matter expert.
- Student notes received by registrants via email.
- All who successfully complete the course receive an official letter of completion.
